Why Become an Enrolled Agent?

- An enrolled agent (EA) is a tax professional who has achieved the highest credential the Internal Revenue Service offers.
- EAs are authorized to represent taxpayers before the IRS and have unlimited representation rights. This means EAs can represent any taxpayer, whether they prepare returns for them or not. EAs can also represent any tax matter and appeal to any office of the IRS.
- The EA credential is valid in any state. An EA is a federally accredited tax practitioner who may represent taxpayers before the IRS.

How do you become an Enrolled Agent?

• You must take and pass the three Special Enrollment Examination (SEE) exams. Part 1: Individuals, Part 2: Businesses, Part 3: Representation, Practices, and Procedures. Exams cost \$206 each.
